Gather for two evenings to learn more about Muslims and the Gospel moving from challenges to opportunities for knowing our Muslim neighbors.

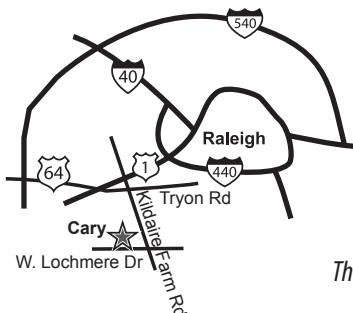
### **Sunday, August 8** - Evening Session Part 1
