Who can participate?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Sunday School Children -Dayschool Children -Preschool Children -After-School Children -Home-School Children -Teens & Preteens -Adults of all descriptions
Subject Matter?	<p>Reformation Themes & General Christian Themes such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The Reformation Itself -Christ Centered Nature of Worship -Sacraments -Priesthood of All Believers in action -Christian Home Life -Illustrations from Bible stories -Illustrations from the Small Catechism -Value of Family Life
How can it be presented?	<p>2D Artwork in any media 8 ½ x 11 size – on Card Stock or Poster Board cut to that size No frames</p>
How do we label?	<p>No names on the front Put Artist Name, Age, Congregation/School/Group and City and State on the Back</p>
Where will the art be displayed?	<p>In Dorton Arena, in the area behind the Main Stage (where the Worship Service will take place), there will be boards to display the art. It will be grouped according to the submitting Congregation/School/Group, with a special section for Individuals.</p>
When is the Art Show?	<p>November 5th from 12Noon to 7PM</p>

When is it due?	<p>We need the Art by October 15th so that we make sure we have enough display space.</p>
How can I get the artwork back?	<p>If you would like it to be mailed back, please send an envelope big enough with your address and postage included. Or you can pick it up at 7PM at Dorton Arena. If no other arrangements have been made, it will be discarded, so let Susan Creech know if you need to make any special arrangements.</p>
